

Conference / Event Attendee Terms & Conditions

These are the Terms & Conditions that apply to YAKIMA CHIEF HOPS (the “producer”) clients that attend events produced and presented by Yakima Chief Hops.

Attendance Requirements: All registered attendees must be 21 years or older, no exceptions.

Payments: All bookings made prior to the conference must be paid in full to guarantee registration. Once payment has been received, an email confirmation and a receipted invoice will be sent.

Cancellation Policy: Our cancellation policy allows for a full refund for cancellations received in writing at least six (6) weeks prior to the event date. No refunds will be made after this date. Cancellation refunds 4-6 weeks out from the event will receive up to 75% of their registration fee and 2-4 weeks out will receive 50%. Cancellation refunds 0-2 weeks out from the event are not eligible for a refund. Substitutions may be made up to 72 hours prior to the event date. If a registered delegate does not cancel and fails to attend the conference, this will be treated as a cancellation and no refund will be issued.

Speakers: Views expressed by speakers are their own. YAKIMA CHIEF HOPS cannot accept liability for advice given, or views expressed, by any speaker at the conference or in any material provided to attendees. YAKIMA CHIEF HOPS may use the speaker’s name and presentation materials for promoting attendance at the conference. YAKIMA CHIEF HOPS may audio and/or video tape the speaker’s session and the recording may be reproduced as part of the overall conference materials. YAKIMA CHIEF HOPS may reproduce copies of the speaker’s presentation (eg. PowerPoint slides or supporting handouts) on paper and/or electronically. Any acknowledgement regarding Copyright or support should be included at the end of the abstract/presentation, as these will be distributed to the conference delegates. Speakers who do not wish to give permission for the above terms and conditions should contact the events team before the commencement of the conference.

Data Protection: By submitting registration details, delegates agree to allow YAKIMA CHIEF HOPS to contact them regarding their services. Delegates who do not wish to receive such communications please contact the events team [here](#). The contact details of registered delegates will not be passed/sold to other companies or shared with conference attendees.

Websites & Links: The conference and associated YAKIMA CHIEF HOPS websites may link to other websites and networking tools provided for the convenience of the users. The contents of these websites are maintained by their owners, for which YAKIMA CHIEF HOPS takes no responsibility. Neither can responsibility be taken for contents of any website linking to this website.

Insurance: It is the responsibility of the attendee to arrange appropriate insurance cover in connection with their attendance at the conference. YAKIMA CHIEF HOPS cannot be held liable for any loss, liability or damage to personal property.

Credentials: YAKIMA CHIEF HOPS-issued credentials are the sole property of the Conference Organizer and must be surrendered upon demand to YAKIMA CHIEF HOPS representatives. YAKIMA CHIEF HOPS-issued credentials must be prominently displayed while at the conference/event or designated off-site activities. False certification of an individual as an attendee or exhibitor's representative, misuse of an attendee badge, or any other method or device used to assist unauthorized personnel to gain admittance to the conference and/or exhibit floor, will be just cause for expelling the attendee and his representative(s) from the conference and/or banning them from future entrance into the conference. The attendee, his/her employees and agents, and anyone claiming to be in the conference through the attendee, waives any rights or claims for damages arising out of the enforcement of this rule.

Admittance: In its sole discretion and without refund, YAKIMA CHIEF HOPS reserves the right to refuse admittance to or expel from the conference/event anyone that it determines is behaving in a manner that could be disruptive to the conference or any other attendee.

Force Majeure: YAKIMA CHIEF HOPS shall not be held responsible for any delay or failure in performance of its obligations hereunder to the extent such delay or failure is caused by fire, flood, strike, civil, governmental or military authority, acts of God, acts of terrorism, acts of war, epidemics, the availability of the Venue or other similar causes beyond its reasonable control and without the fault or negligence of YAKIMA CHIEF HOPS or its subcontractors. For one or more of such reasons, YAKIMA CHIEF HOPS may postpone, reschedule or cancel the event without liability on the part of YAKIMA CHIEF HOPS. In the event the conference cannot be held or is postponed pursuant to this section, YAKIMA CHIEF HOPS shall not be liable to attendee for any damages, costs, or losses incurred, such as transportation costs, accommodations costs, or financial losses. YAKIMA CHIEF HOPS will review refund and/or fee transfer requests, submitted in writing, for approval on a situational basis.
